What next? The videos will be reviewed by the local team who will select 3 finalists to go forward to the live final at The Howard School in Rainham on 4th October 2025. Finalists will be announced by 30th June.

Finalists will need to attend one Choir rehearsal in Canterbury – these are: 12th July, 27th Sept to have a rehearsal of their performance and learn the finale song(s). Rehearsals take place in the afternoon; exact call times will be agreed nearer the time. They can attend with or without leaders.

Finalists can attend the final with or without leaders.
